



General campsite regulations

For alle guests who hire a pitch or accommodation

- On arrival, please report to reception.
- Guests and visitors must be notified immediately upon arrival.
- Tandem axle / double axle caravans are not allowed.
- Your caravan, folding trailer, or tent must be placed on the grass tiles behind the artificial grass. The artificial grass is intended for the awning / canopy.
- Please use only air- and light-permeable tent carpets. Rugs damage the turf; guests after you would also like a nice lawn.
- Your car may only be parked on your own pitch. Don't have enough space? Then you can get a parking ticket for the car park at reception.
- The barriers are closed from 10.30 pm to 7.30 am. If you wish to enter or leave the campsite outside these hours, please park your car outside the campsite.
- Driving around the campsite at walking pace.
- On the day of departure, you are requested to leave the pitch before noon (rental accommodations before 10 am).
- If you pass by reception, you can check your electricity usage and receive any refund of your deposit. Staying longer is only possible in consultation with the reception.
- The camping fee includes 4 kWh of electricity (5 kWh with 10 Amp). Any additional usage will be settled upon departure with the deposit already paid at € 0.55 per kWh (2026).
- Open fires are prohibited on the campsite.
- Electric heaters may not be used from April tot November.
- Dispose of waste at the environmental park in the designated containers (household waste, glass and paper; no bulky waste!).
- It is not permitted to wash cars on the campsite.
- Tents may not be set up next to the rental accommodation.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
- A maximum of 2 dogs are allowed per pitch.
- Dogs are not allowed in the Chalets, Lodges and Coco Sweets.
- Do not leave your pet alone in a hot camping vehicle. If you do, we feel obliged to inform the police and you run the risk of your camping equipment being broken into to free your pet.
- The campsite is not a dog walking area. You are therefore obliged to carry a poop bag with you at all times on the campsite to clean up any accidents immediately. You can walk your dog outside the campsite.



- Our reception is designated solely for receiving guests, not packages. Therefore, we kindly ask you to have your packages delivered to a pickup point. Should a package be delivered to our reception, we will need to charge a handling fee of €5 per package.
